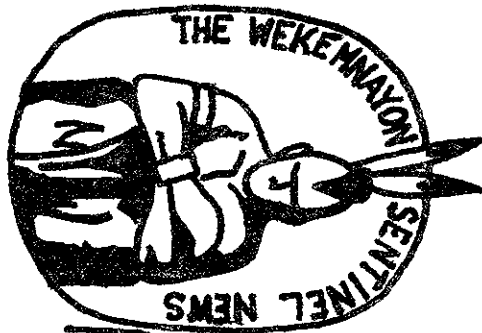

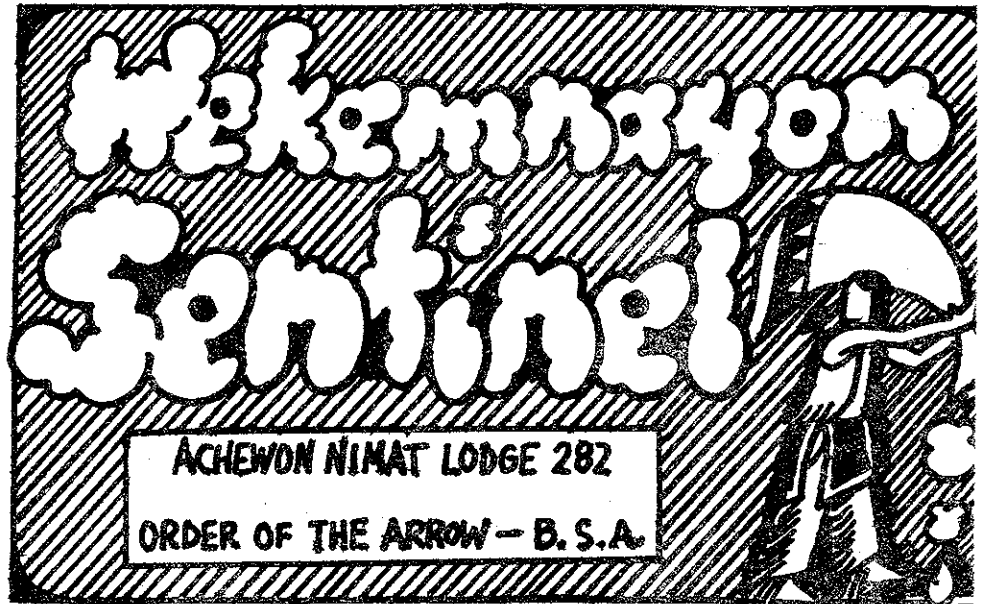

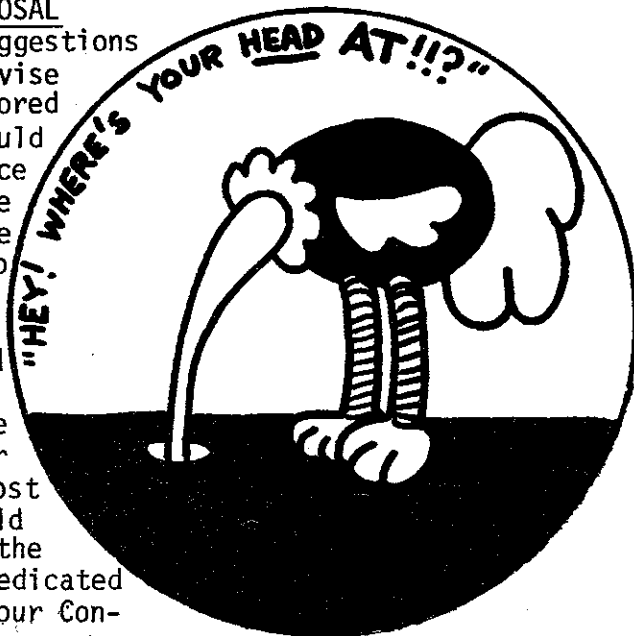
Greetings, My Brothers!

BICENTENNIAL AWARDS

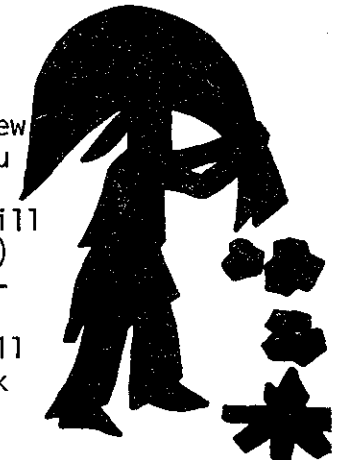
