There will be plenty of snow to ski, tobogon, snowfights, or just foofing around. Those that went to last years snowtrip knows that the cabin we stayed in was a dream house. You must also provide your own transportation to and from the cabin. Talk to your Village Chiefs about transportation.

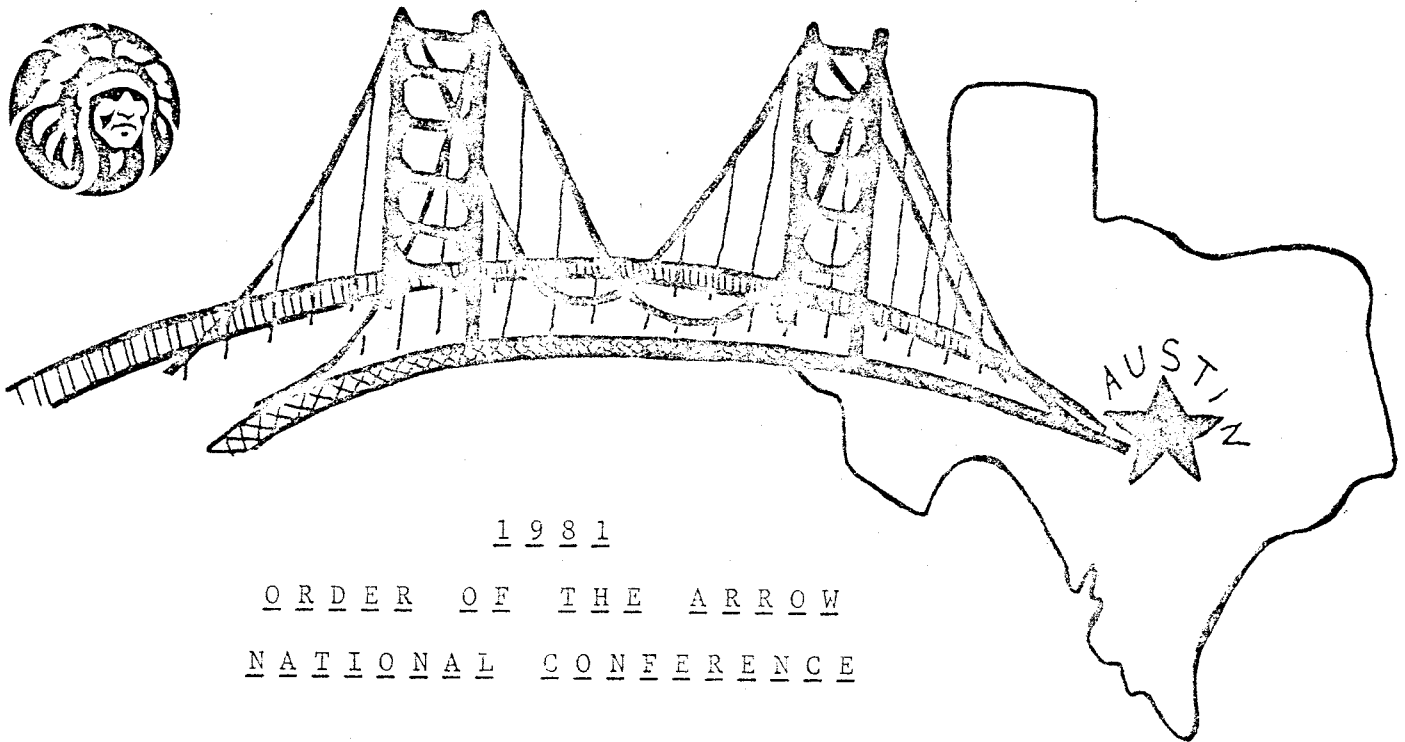
