NOAC - NOAC stands for National Orders of the Arrow Conference and has been held every two or three years since 1948. NOAC 2018 will be the 33rd conference held and is the largest event put on for members of the OA (think of a small Jamboree).

In the summer of 2018, NOAC will be held at the Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana from July 30 until August 4. Indiana University Bloomington is the flagship campus of the Indiana University system and was rated as one of the most beautiful campuses in the United States in 2011. The town of Bloomington (population 88,322) is about four hours south of Chicago, IL.

As the campus has limited space, Achewon Nimat Lodge has been designated a membership quota of 14 arrowmen (11 youth & 3 adults) that will be allowed to attend the event. Typically our contingent will do some form of touring before the event. At NOAC 2015, we spent 2 days in Chicago, toured a WWII U-boat, and dined on pizza at the Gino's (the birthplace of the deep-dish pizza) and many other exciting events.
