



ORDER of the ARROW - ADULT CANDIDATE RECOMMENDATION

(Age 21 and over)

Selection and induction into the Order of the Arrow of an adult Scouter takes place only when the adult's job in Boy Scouts or Varsity Scouting will make the Order of the Arrow membership more meaningful in the lives of the youth membership. It must not be for the purpose of adult recognition. Recommendations must be submitted by the nominee's primary unit of registration. Incomplete recommendations will not be considered or returned.

Lodge approval REQUIRED before Callout Ceremony. Allow 30/45 days from date submitted to the Lodge for approval.

Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates which resulted in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may recommend one adult to the lodge adult selection committee. Troops or teams with more than 50 registered active youth members may recommend an additional adult. The following conditions are the basis for candidates selection and MUST be fulfilled to be considered. Make a brief statement regarding the individual for each item.
